October 14, 2020: The DOWNTOWN EVANSVILLE – Economic Improvement District (EID) is welcoming the community to the third annual NoCo Makers Market on Sunday, October 18.

Shop 40+ makers, enjoy live music, a pumpkin patch, food trucks, a beer garden, and a free no-touch yoga session at the NoCo Makers Market on Sunday, October 18. The event will take place from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. along Carpenter Street from Second to Third Street in Downtown Evansville.

Admission is free. The health and safety of attendees is the top priority of the EID. The outdoor event will include hand washing stations and sanitizing stations; maker booths will be spaced to allow for social distancing; face masks will be required in areas where participants are unable to social distance; and, volunteers and staff will be temperature checked prior to beginning work.

The first 200 children in attendance will receive a free pumpkin, sponsored by TOOLS 4 Teaching. Kids can grab a pre-packaged craft bag to decorate their pumpkin at home. Guests will enjoy music by Rewind, sponsored by Romain Automotive Group. Bruce Li, Cheese Queen, Duffy Shuffle, Kool Shack, Jayson Munoz Caters, and River City Coffee + Goods will be selling food and Myriad Brewing Company will host a beer garden. Bring your mat and join a free yoga session led by a certified YMCA yoga instructor from 10:00 – 11:00 a.m. or create a chalk masterpiece during the sidewalk chalk contest.

Available maker items for sale will include art paintings, candles, custom wood décor, flowers, lotion, jewelry, soap, and more. Carpenter Street will be closed from Second Street to Third Street for the event.

The area North of Court Street was designated as the “NoCo Makers District” in the Downtown Evansville Master Plan in 2016. “The EID is pleased to host this event, now in its third year, as we continue to advance the long-term focus of making NoCo a place where people live and work, enhancing the diversity and appeal of our Downtown,” said Josh Armstrong, president, EID.
